

Subject Fipronil Alert in eggs
Notification RASSFF # 2017.1065 – 20.07.2017
Date August 03rd, 2017

To whom it may concern,

CSM Bakery Solutions is fully aware of the Notification Alert from the European Rapid Alert system RASSFF # 2017.1065 dated the 20th of July 2017 where Belgium reported residues from 0.0031 to 1.2 ppm of Fipronil in eggs of various origins, which may be commercially available in the Netherlands, Belgium, Italy, Poland and Germany.

Fipronil belongs to the phenyl pyrazole chemical family and is widely used as a plant protection product and biocide, in veterinary medicine for the control of ectoparasites.

However, the use in food-producing animals is prohibited.

On basis of our egg supplier responses and to the best of our knowledge CSM Bakery Solutions can confirm that the eggs used in our production of finished goods delivered to our customers are not involved in the above contamination.
